DOLENJSKE TOPLICE

Sights and attractions of the town, you cannot miss

The town of Dolenjske Toplice, also known to locals as Toplice, was named after hot water springs. The first written source of the name dates back to the year 1215. As the second oldest thermal spa in the former Carniola region, Dolenjske Toplice was often written on maps. In 1604, the town was graphically depicted for the first time. It is a spa town known for its thermal baths established between 1673 and 1677 by the Counts of Auersperg. 250 years ago (1768), it was replaced by

a bathing house (today Hotel Vital). In front of it there is a thermal spa (today Hotel Kristal). It was built by the plans of the architect Max Conrad in 1899. Inside, there is a painted restaurant hall adorned with a magnificent chandelier. The northern backyard of both buildings fills the park, lined with a century-old avenue of lime trees and chestnuts.

At the beginning of the 18th century, Toplice gained





market rights. In the center there were 21 houses. Two destructive fires (1834 and 1895), changed living condition and the expansion of the spa resulted in their gradual withdrawal to the outskirts of the town. Therefore, a spacious spa square developed in the center. It is marked by a century-old village lime tree and a cast-iron fountain next to it, the product of the former Auersperg iron works in Dvor, with the thermal water splashing out of it. At the edge of the square there is a modern hotel Balnea.

In addition to health resorts, the most prominent attraction of Toplice is the parish church of St. Anne. In its base it is most likely a Romanesque building and it was renovated in 15th century, after the Auerspergs obtained the patronage rights. The main renovations took place in the 17th century, during the time of the architecturally educated

priest Matija Kastelec (1646–1657). He also built the church belfry, renovated the presbytery and decorated it with vaults. Due to Turkish invasions, a camp complex was built around the church in the early 16th century. It is characterized by three defense towers, from which the southwestern one is the best preserved.

The towers were connected by a 5 m high firewall with portholes, from which the south side is still preserved and visible.

A walk over the big and small bridge will reveal some of the great houses from the beginning of the 20th century. Many of them show ambitious design with a rich façade decoration and imaginatively designed ventilation lines in facade gutters. There are many hidden gems on both banks of the Sušica torrent, waiting to be discovered.

DOLENJSKE TOPLICE THERMAL SPA

Second oldest thermal spa in former Carniola

The past and the future of Dolenjske Toplice is tightly intertwined with thermal water that has given this town its distinctive architecture and influenced the ways of living. Thanks to its long and vivid history, Dolenjske Toplice has become a synonym for thermal tourism in former Carniola. Not many spa resorts can boast with such a number of written water analyses, description of the town and its picturesque surroundings, dating from 1777.

It is difficult to pinpoint the exact time of when the healing properties of thermal springs in Dolenjske Toplice were discovered. In 15th century the town was already known for their health springs, which were outside and open to everyone. During the centuries, there were many different owners of the

property. Duke Janez Vajkard I. Auersperg built the first bathing building above the thermal springs in the second half of the 17th century, and in this way he created the foundations for the long-term development of the town towards thermal tourism.

Duke Henrik Auersperg is most significant historical figure of the town. Between 1767 and 1768 he built the hotel Vital, which was the most outstanding thermal building in Carniola. The resort was built in Tuscan style; it had four floors, three indoor pools in the basement and 28 guestrooms in the floors. Anton Kastelec, a distinguished doctor from Ljubljana, conducted the first thermal water analysis and published it in Vienna. After that, Dolenjske Toplice has been known as one of the most elite





thermal spa resorts in Austro-Hungary. The dukes of Auersperg renovated the spa several times, the last time in 1899, when Hotel Kristal was built. In 1922 it was sold to their then tenant, Czech doctor Konstanin Konvalinka, who was forced to surrender it to Agricultural Loan Bank of Ljubljana. The turning-point in post-war time is the year of 1973, when the thermal spa resort connected with Pharmaceutical Factory Krka from Novo Mesto.

Today, Thermal Spa Dolenjske Toplice is an attractive destination for all generations from all over Europe. Top-notch Balnea wellness centre nestled at the edge of the spa's park with hundred-year-old trees is a kingdom of refreshing baths, invigorating massages, revitalizing saunas and water pampering.

It has become one of the most prominent wellness centres with its individually planned and tailor-made programmes and services for people of all ages. Wide range of services at Balnea is complemented by a facial and body treatment centre with its unique programmes with the goal of promoting a better quality of life. HONEY ROUTE TOUR

Enjoy the taste of fir tree honey, first-rate liqueurs, and artisan chocolate

Fir Tree Honey, a local feature of Dolenjske Toplice valley.

The woods around Dolenjske Toplice are the lowest site of fir tree in Slovenia and even Europe. Fir tree honey (hojavec) is one of the most appreciated forest honeys. It is made from the honeydew, collected from certain insect species that feed off fir tree sap.



Plains of Radešca.

Radešca creek is the most water-rich affluent of the river Krka in the whole valley of Dolenjske Toplice. The 3.5 km long creek springs in Podturn and flows along feet of mountains Pogorelec and Cvinger. This karst creek is home to fish, otters and beavers, and on the flooded plains there are blooming meadows.

Depths of the Obrh spring

What distinguishes the Obrh creek from others is its heavy karst spring. Under the den, the underground lake flows into creek that later joins with Radešca creek. The underground lake is 19 metres deep. At the bottom there is an entry into a siphon, which at the depth of 33 meters leads to the Roš massif and ends in a rockfall at 120 metres.

Beekeeping Business Šercelj

The beekeeping business runs in the family already for three generations. The traditional Slovenian AZ hives are home to 300 bee families which are neatly transported to different honey pastures all over Slovenia. For the means of transportation, they developed a special system that allows a beekeeper to tend to his bees and offers a pleasant workplace for a beekeeper. The family is always eager to show their beekeeping traditions to visitors; moreover, there is a wide range of honeys, honey delicacies (pollen, propolis, bee wax) and honey beverages, the visitors are always welcome to taste.

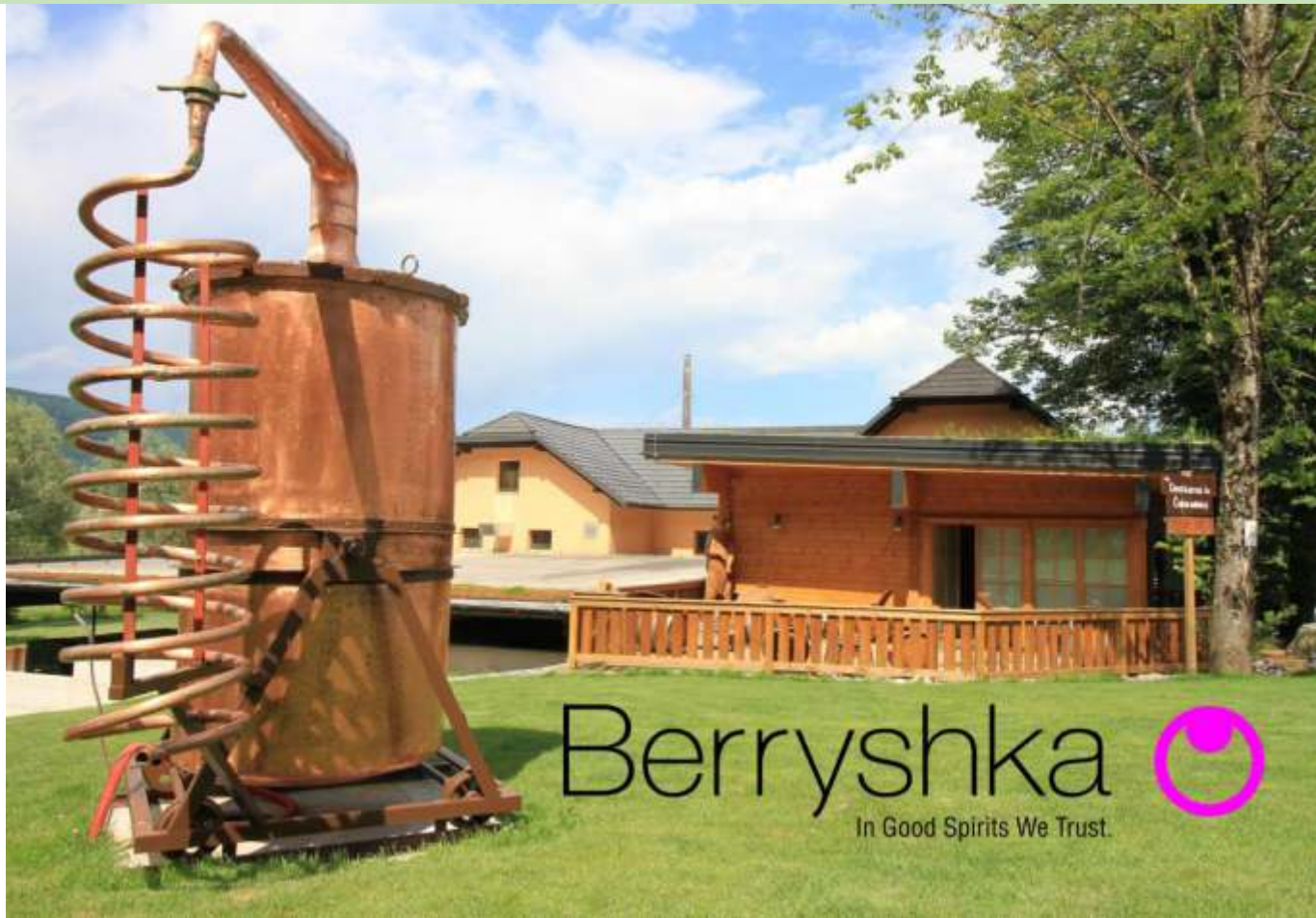

Guesthouse Kolesar is a family restaurant business since 1981. In their restaurant they take reservations for groups, they offer formal lunches, wedding receptions, anniversary parties and other events. Farm Plavica is an herb farm. Plants with healing properties are grown on one hectare area and are also collected in nature. Preventative and curative mixtures are concocted out of these plants. Jože Majes mixes over 200 kinds of teas for different health problems, and other healing concoctions. Visitors gladly sneak a peek of the herb garden. There are three young people employed on the



farm. There were times where the farm visited up to 150 buses of tourists a year.

OFFER: over 60 home-made eco products: teas, tea mixtures, ointments, tinctures, powders, oils, immunity boosting paste. Jože Majes' books on herbalism are a real hit. There are also weekend seminars, where you can learn more about healing plants and their use, and they also organize lectures abroad.

WORKING HOURS: On week-days from 8.00 until 16.00, tours can be booked throughout the week, but not during winter.

Church at Gorica

The subsidiary church of Mary Help of Christians is the most noted pilgrimage church in the Topliška Valley. The pilgrims were mostly Gottscheers, and the church had the same reputation as the one in Brezje. Why pilgrimage appeared here, remains a mystery. The church stands on a 250 metres high terrace above the Črmošnjiška valley. A magnificent belfry with a simple tented roof and octagonal nave showcase a lavish Baroque design. According to Carniolan historian Valvasor, the church was built in 1680 and then in 1710 the belfry was finished. Some believe that this baroque church was built in

the same place as her gothic ancestor once stood. Valuable baroque features are the main altar and two side altars. The main altar is dedicated to Mary and side two to Holy Trinity and St. Barbara. Stations of the Cross are copies of Fuerich with accompanying prayers in German.

Church at Cerovec

On top of the wine-growing hill Cerovec near Gorica there is another church, the subsidiary church of Holy Trinity. The closeness of the two churches is

surprising. Both are relatively lavish, which gives an impression of neighbor rivalry between Slovenes and Gottscheers. The church was built in 17th century in baroque style. At the same time, the altar was made, which is furnished by local fine artists. All altars are rich with divisions and decorated with quality plastics. The golden main altar dates from the second half of 17th century, time of a beautiful and calm baroque period. The main apse is decorated with figures of Holy Trinity, putting a crown on Mary's head.

KOČEVSKI ROG

The tales of nature and wartime memories

Kočevski Rog is a place of spectacular natural and cultural heritage. Five centuries ago, Kočevski Rog was thinly populated area of old-growth forest. In 14th century German immigrants began to cultivate it, and after 1941, when ethnic German Gottscheer population was resettled, the area became almost completely devoid of humans again. This area of karst massif is defined by dense fir and beech forest. By the end of 19th century, the forest was guided through sustainable development by Auersperg's forest estate manager, Leopold Hufnagel. Many parts of this area are preserved virgin forests with diverse flora and fauna. The

wilderness of Kočevski Rog serves as a refuge for animal species such as bear, wolf and lynx. What makes the area even more special is karst plateau with more than 1000 karst caves.

Hiking trails and tours

There are many themed trails to discover the nature: Polharska and Padalska Trail, Trail to St. Peter, Trail of Resistance (Pot upora), and Educational forest trail "Rožek" (Naravoslovna gozdna pot Rožek). Key peaks and sights are connected by Trdinova Trail and bike paths. The access is arranged to Podstenice and Rožek collapse dolines and also to Ice Cave





(Ledena jama) in Kunč. There you can see two mighty trees the Črmošnjice fir tree (Črmošnjiška jelka) and the Spruce at Kunč.

The cultural heritage of this area is marked by traces of vanished Gottschee villages, ruins of steam powered sawmills at Sawmill Rog and Sawmill Podstenice. Most renowned WW2 monuments are the preserved Jelendol Partisan Hospital, Zgornji Hrastnik hospital, and Point 20 (Baza 20), the only secret headquarters of any European resistance movement built in such a manner. The locations of post-war killings in Rugarski Klanci and Double Cave by the Zinc Cross (Dvojno brezno pri Cink križu) are also commemorated.

RUINS OF SOTESKA MANSION

The forgotten past

According to Valvasor, the Soteska Mansion was one of the most beautiful mansions in Carniola. It had a rectangular layout with an interior courtyard bordered by rectangular towers at the corners which highlighted the early baroque architecture. In 1943 it was burnt down by partisans, and after the war, the mansion was used as a quarry for road-making.

The Auersperg family, that managed the estate since 1793, depended on Rog forests. In 1856, a sawmill was set up by Krka river, which was powered by a

steam locomotive, still preserved today. Since 1927 a power station is operating at the site of the former mill. In 19th century, the Auerspergs even brewed their own beer.

Above the mansion there is a church of St. Erasmus, an institution of Sirs of Soteska. The church was built in 17th century by the Gallenbergs.

Park with the Devil's Tower (Hudičev turn)

The garden pavilion together with the park composition presents one of the most important



early Baroque monuments in Slovenia. The park concept was developed at the end of 17th century. The garden pavilion is a quatrefoil-shaped Baroque tower, surrounded by stone wall with three portals, as a place to escape reality into mystique. The interior is painted with illusionistic frescoes, which are attributed to the Dutch painter Almanach.

Vintage Car Museum

In a former castle farmhouse in front of the mansion ruins there is a museum depot of vintage cars, wagons, and fire pumps, which are operated

by Bistra, Technical Museum of Slovenia.

Tour: There is an information table at the parking space by the castle

The tour of the Devil's Tower and the Vintage Car Museum is possible from 27. April to 30. September, every day, including Sundays and Holidays, between 13:00 and 18:00, or at any time by prior notification to TIC Dolenjske Toplice (07 384 51 88 or tic@dolenjske-toplice.si)



GOTTSCHEE GERMAN HERITAGE

Preserving the legacy

Gottscheers or Gottschee Germans are the German-speaking settlers of the Kočevje region. They first settled there around 1330 and stayed there until the beginning of WWII in 1941. The centre of the German language island was the city of Kočevje.

Today, the legacy of Gottscheers is maintained by Gottschee Germans Society, established in 1992 in Občice. The members are mostly Gottscheers and

their descendants from Črmošnjiško-Poljanska Valley and surroundings who were not resettled.

The society resides in Museum and Cultural Centre of Občice. In one of the two buildings there is a smaller museum collection of Gottscheers' history, and in the other building there are various models of Gottschee villages and houses. German language courses and folk group classes also take place in the cultural centre. They present their lifestyle during





the Days of Gottschee Culture, a festival that takes place in Kočevske Poljane in Občice once every three years.

Tour: Visitors can take the tour by prior notification. Visitors are welcomed by honey liquor and typical

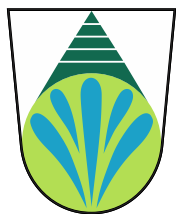
